
Snow Policy

When it snows and Albuquerque Public Schools go on an abbreviated schedule, Serendipity will open at 9:30 to give families and staff a chance to arrive at school safely. On snowy mornings, please watch the local news, (KOAT doesn't always broadcast preschool info) check the news websites or check the Serendipity Facebook page to see if we are opening late. If extremely bad weather hits during the day, we may call and ask families to pick up children so we can close early. --Please do not confuse the APS East Mountain schools' delays or closures with what is happening in the metro area--

Car Seats

If you need to leave a car seat at Serendipity for another person who is picking up your child, please label the car seat with your child's name to avoid confusion and put it on top of your child's cubby in the atrium, or in our entryway for Room #5 children. We cannot have car seats left at school for long periods of time, but from morning to afternoon on the same day or for a field trip it is fine.



Cubbies

The start of the new year is a good time to clean out your child's cubby and take home clothes that no longer fit or are out of season. Be sure to take art work and accumulated items from home as well. The cubbies should not be overflowing, so please make sure your child's nap things fit inside, and the tops should be clutter free so please do not put anything on top of your child's cubby (except car seats).
